**TRACKING TEST AWARD**

A Green Rosette will be awarded to each handler/dog team that passes the Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Excellent test.

A commemorative medallion and collar will be awarded to each Chesapeake Bay Retriever handler/dog team that passes the Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Excellent test.

**IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS**

**CERTIFICATION:** With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test there must be filed an original statement dated within one year and signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests (or Provisional Tracking Judge), certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test.

**TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW:** This test is limited to 4 TD & 3 TDX dogs. Entries will remain open until 5:00 p.m., WEDNESDAY, 8/22/07. If entries received exceed the test limit of 10 dogs, a public drawing will be held WEDNESDAY, August 22, 2007, at 7:00 p.m. at the Village Inn Restaurant, 9205 Crown Crest Blvd Parker, CO. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to Chesapeake Bay Retrievers first, followed by other breeds. If limits for entries are not reached in one test area & entries are exceeded in another, the number of tracks may be exchanged at the ratio of 2 TDs for 1 TDX.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$50.00 – TD; \$100.00 TDX. (This includes the \$0.50 AKC recording fee and the \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee.) Make checks payable to American Chesapeake Club and send, with TD Test Judge’s Certification, to the Event Secretary:

**ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note" on page 4 of this premium list), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE.** The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

**USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM** and write "Tracking Dog" or "Tracking Dog Excellent" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Entries sent by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** must be marked “no signature required.”

**THE ORDER OF RUNNING** will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** Any exhibitor whose dog passes a TD test AFTER the closing date for the ACC test but BEFORE the running of the test may withdraw their entry and receive full refund of the entry fee PROVIDED that such withdrawal is made by phone, in writing or in person to the Test Secretary **at least 48 hours prior to the test** and FURTHER PROVIDED that alternate exhibitors are available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

**RISK:** The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The American Chesapeake Club assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

**For exhibitors coming from out of state**, please remember you are coming to a higher altitude, which can affect health. The thin air means handler and dog must be in good condition. Our semi-arid climate also means both handler and dog will need to consume more water than might be expected.

**IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING OUR TEST SITE:** Exhibitors are requested to not practice at the test site within three days of the test without first contacting the test chairperson to find out which areas may be used. **Exhibitors and spectators are not permitted to park along the park roads.** This is a park rule! Designated drivers will take exhibitors and spectators to drop-off or viewing points.
